The Bobcats are undefeated so far this month: 4-0, and have now won 16 straight in the month of Feb Haven't lost a game since February of 2020 (at App State, game that Nijal Pearson didn't play in) Their record in the month of February since the 2018-19 season is 24-3

STORYLINES

After a 5-2 start to conference play, the Red Wolves have stumbled a bit (dropped 3 of last 4) Two of those losses came by a combined 3 points, and the other came with key players out That loss came this past Saturday at USA (Desi Sills & Keyon Wesley DNP, Caleb Field hurt early)

Tonight, looking to bounce back and sweep the season series from TXST for the first time since 2014

Another 1st Balado looking to achieve: getting A-State to first NCAA since 1999 (only one team history)

ALL TIME SERIES: (TODAY IS 15TH Meeting...TXST leads 10-4)

Before A-State's win last month, TXST had won 10 straight over the Red Wolves
Arkansas State hasn't swept season series since TXST's first year in the Sun Belt in 2014
That was also the last time that Arkansas State won IN San Marcos
